1. **S-138 Hoylman-Sigal, A-136 Paulin** - Medically Assisted Suicide.

2. **S824 Krueger, A01474 Dinowitz** - Green Fund program to underwrite unsustainable state environmental programs.  
Party Position: Opposed
3. **S8417 Krueger, A08888 Simon** - Ends gas hookups for new construction.  
Party Position: Opposed
4. **S4914 Hoylman-Sigal, A05480C Bronson** - An act to allow NYS to override the laws of other jurisdictions outside the state.  
Party Position: Opposed
5. **S8344 Gounardes, A08787 Glick** - Expands and extends school speed zones in NYC.  
Party Position: Opposed
6. **S630A Harckham, A8330A Woerner** - Allows for the use of crossbows for hunting.

7. **S3000D/A300d - (Budget) STATE OPERATIONS BUDGET**

14. **S5225A Gounardes, A1970A Paulin** - Improves the tracking and timeframe in which sexual offense evidence is delivered to a laboratory upon the consent of the victim.

15. **S1889 Ashby, A29 McDonald, Bendett**- Designates the State of New York as a Purple Heart State.

16. **S3009-C, A3009-C (Budget)** - Enacts into law major components of legislation which are necessary to implement the state fiscal plan for the 2025-2026 state fiscal year; relates to establishing an inflation refund credit; provides for a middle-class tax cut; extends the temporary personal income tax high income surcharge

17. **S8415 Salazar, A8871 Dilan**- Omnibus Prison Bill: Fails to address the environment and general working conditions in the facilities that led to the unprecedented strike. In particular, mandatory overtime, violence, drugs, and the negative impact of the Halt Act.

18. **S205- Martinez, Ashby, Borrello** - Classify the threat to disseminate or publish an intimate image or video as a criminal offense.

19. **S135 Cleare** - Expands abortion access and NYS Government support of abortion services.

20. **S1464 Harckham** - An extreme anti-business recycling Bill that will raise costs while being impossible to implement.

18. **A1865 Rosenthal** - Interferes with the property rights of landlords.
